TRIP INFORMATIONAL MEETING: MONDAY, NOVEMBER 7 @ 7:00 P.M.

Trip Dates: June 18-29, 2012

Trip Leader: Mr. Tim Blamer. Mr. Blamer has studied in Israel five times since 2004. He has a passion for teaching the Bible in its original context and for bringing life to the Bible in new and exciting ways that will help others grow in their faith and knowledge of God.

Description: Our study trip to Israel will bring God's Word to life in new and inspiring ways by immersing us in the land, culture, and world of the Bible. As we walk in the footsteps of Abraham, David, and Jesus, our faith will be deepened and our passion to live for God will be strengthened in ways that will last long after we return home. We will travel the Land and study the Bible in-depth in its original setting. Our time at each site will include sightseeing, teaching, reflection time, and hiking. We will learn with our minds, our hearts, our hands, and our feet.



Cost: \$3599. Includes flights, lodging, transportation, food, admission fees, etc. Participants will be responsible for other costs including passports, lunch, souvenirs, personal items, clothing, hiking boots, etc.

Deposits: The trip deposit will be \$400. Students who pay the deposit by December 1 will be entered into a drawing for a \$500 credit towards the trip cost.

Transportation and Lodging: Our flight will depart from Detroit and connect through Frankfurt, Germany to Tel Aviv, Israel. Transportation on the ground will be by bus with a licensed company and driver. Lodging in Israel will be at hotels, all of which are modern, clean, safe, and affordable. Breakfast and dinner will be provided at the hotel. Witte Travel in Grand Rapids will be handling the travel arrangements and has years of experience planning trips to Israel.

Optional Course Credit: Because of the pace of study for the trip, high school students will have the option of earning a ½ credit Bible elective through the trip. To earn credit, there would be both a preparatory assignment, journaling on the trip, and a concluding assignment. The assignments will ensure that students are prepared for the trip and applying what they are studying. Credit will be optional for students, but will challenge them to go even deeper and will prove to be personally and spiritually rewarding.
